

# STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

## 1. Preamble

This Code indicates the standard procedures and practices of the Govt College Sidhrawali for all students enrolled with the college for pursuing various programmes. All students must know that they are bound to abide by this code and expected to accept responsibilities including restrictions.

The College's objective by enforcing this Code is to administer the students to the path of discipline that is egalitarian and conscientious, and promotes students' growth and development through individual and collective responsibility. All the students must be well versed with this Code, which can also be eyed on the official website of the College.

## 2. Jurisdiction

The college shall have the jurisdiction over the conduct of the students enrolled and to take cognizance of any act of misconduct including incidents of ragging or otherwise which are taking place in the campus. The college may also exercise jurisdiction over conduct which occurs off-campus violating the conduct that shall include-

- a) Any violation of Sexual Harassment policy.
- b) Physical Assaults and threats of violence.
- c) Possession of weapon, explosive or any destructive devices.
- d) Use of Drugs, alcohol and Tobacco.
- e) Any act of discrimination (physical or verbal) based on gender identity, cast, religion, colour, region, language, disability and family status.
- f) Conduct which has negative impact on the campus and off-campus community.

## 3. Ethics and Conduct

This Code shall apply to all kinds of conduct of students that occurs in the campus including activities, functions and any off-campus conduct that has adverse impact on the reputation or interest of the college. At the time of admission, each student must have an inner realization that...

- a) he/she shall be regular and must attend the classes, and complete his/her studies.
- b) he/she must uphold academic integrity and maintain the behavioural standards.
- c) he/she must deter from all forms of misconduct including partaking in off-campus activities which can affect reputation of the College.
- d) he/she will not damage or destroy property of the college and not let others to do so.
- e) he/she shall put efforts to keep the campus neat and clean.
- f) he/she shall produce the identity card issued by the college, on demand by security guard or any faculty in the campus.
- g) he/she must preserve other's privacy and will use social media carefully and responsibly, and will not upload any audio or video recording clips of any in-campus activity, on social media without prior permission.

#### 4. Dress Code

The objective of the dress code is to maintain an atmosphere conducive to learning. Appropriate dress is neat and clean, and should be suitable for an educational setting. Clothes that strain the bounds of modesty are inappropriate in the institute settings. Clothing should also not be lewd or otherwise objectionable. Footwear is to be worn at all times. Students are to refrain from wearing Bermudas, bathroom slippers/flippers to classroom.
